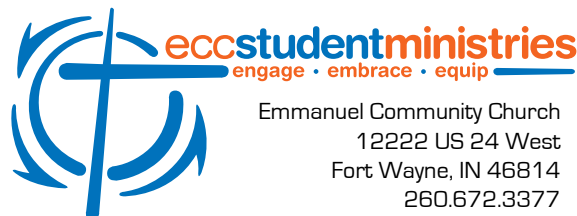

## GLOBAL IMPACT

Our Global Impact program is a HUGE part of ECC Student Ministries. We feel that it is critical for teenagers to experience the Church in a larger context outside of their local community. That's why we spend a great deal of time and effort to make sure they have that opportunity through our Global Impact programs.

This program is made up of three basic components...

- Summer Mission Trips
- Fundraising

## THE OPPORTUNITIES

While our summer mission trips are a big part of our identity as a student ministry, we understand that they are also a BIG financial commitment on your part. In order to help off-set the cost for you, we offer multiple opportunities to raise funds...

The month of October brings us to our first fundraiser, **MIKES CAR WASH**. Students can sell car wash passes for the locally owned Mikes Car Wash. This fundraiser will conclude in November. These passes make great Christmas gifts!

The **PIZZA SALE** takes place in the month of January. After three weeks of pre-selling we spend the afternoon of Superbowl Sunday together making and delivering the pizzas. (Top earnings: \$370. Ave. earnings: \$86.)

Our high school students host their annual **PANCAKE BREAKFAST** in April. (Ave. earnings: \$58.)
